- All exhibits must be registered with National Buckskin Society (Inc.) and exhibitors must be financial members
- **INSURANCE** - Every participant at this event who will be a handler, rider, driver, groom and anyone handling a horse or pony, must complete an AHSA '[Liability Declaration Form for Affiliates](#)'. This form, along with the required supporting documentation should then be given to the Secretary of the NBS Inc, or to their delegate at the Show. (Most NBS members have already submitted their form and therefore do not need to re-submit the form again) Riders/Handlers not covered by NBS insurance must pay on the day Insurance levy
- **The National Buckskin Soc. (Inc) committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program.**
- All competitors ride at their own risk . The committee of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) accepts no responsibility for injury or loss to competitors, spectators, livestock and equipment in any way whatsoever.
- **NOVICE** – A NOVICE is a horse/pony any age, not to have won a first prize at a NBS A Class Show or a Royal / or Agricultural Show. This applies to led, ridden and rider classes as appropriate.
- Section B, C & D Horses may only compete in classes where it stipulates the class is Open to Section B, C & D Horses.
- Horses competing in **Dual Registered Classes** **MUST supply a photocopy of the relevant Breed Registration and show proof of ownership.** Only **ONE** Section A Dual Registered class is allowed per horse unless program states otherwise. Papers available on request.
- Entries in Pony Club & Adult Riding Club classes must be in full uniform and carry relevant papers
- Approved safety hard hats must be worn at all times and appropriate footwear must be worn.
- Breeder/Owner class. This is open to a person who bred the horse and owns the horse (the handler of the horse can be anyone).
- Pleasure Horse/Pony must be ridden in a snaffle bit and bridle only
- A show Hunter able to compete in both Open and Hunter Classes

ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

If cancellation of an event is required due to existing or predicted severe and dangerous conditions such as Code Red Fire Warnings/Floods or travel warnings/disease outbreaks, then the following policy will be adhered to: Cancellation will be decided from the 4-day weather forecast given on the Wednesday prior to the event. Information regarding the status of the event will be available on the Society's website: www.nbs.org.au or from the relevant contact person. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event, costs incurred by the Show Committee prior to the event will be paid and the remaining funds will be reimbursed to the exhibitor if the amount per exhibitor is \$10 or more. If an event is postponed, entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement. If an event has commenced there shall be no refunds.
