## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only Horses registered with the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or in the Register of other State Bodies affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association that fall within the Victorian Colour Standard are eligible to compete.

2. All exhibitors must be Financial Members of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or other State Body affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association.

**INSURANCE** - Every participant at this event who will be a handler, rider, driver, groom and anyone handling a horse or pony, must complete an AHSA '**Liability Declaration Form for Affiliates**' This form, along with the required supporting documentation should then be given to the Secretary of the NBS Inc, or to their delegate at the Show. (Most NBS members have already submitted their form and therefore do not need to re-submit the form again)

Riders/Handlers not covered by NBS insurance must pay on the day Insurance levy.

3. **The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program and to reject any entry at its discretion, if the circumstances arise.**

4. All Competitors ride/compete at their own risk. The committee of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) accepts no responsibility for injury or loss to competitors, spectators and equipment in any way whatsoever. 5 A **NOVICE** is a horse/pony any age, not to have won a first place at a NBS A/B Class Show, a Royal or Agricultural Show. This applies to led, ridden and rider classes as appropriate.

6. Horses competing in **Dual Registered Classes MUST supply a photocopy of the relevant Breed Registration and showing proof of ownership.** Only **ONE** Dual Registered class is allowed per horse unless program states otherwise.

7. Approved hard hats ASA AS/NZS 3838, ASTM F1163 must be worn whilst mounted & by juniors under 12yrs who are competing in led events and appropriate footwear must be worn.

8. High Point Horse of the show is a one horse, one handler / rider combination.

9. Breeder/owner class (breeder must be the registered owner)

10. Same combination of horse and rider **CANNOT** compete in both Leading Rein and First Ridden Pony

11. **HARNESS PERFORMANCE CARD** - Classes are to be recorded on their relevant Performance card. ei. Buckskin/Dun horse points go on Buckskin/Dun Harness PC and Section B C & D points go on Section B C or D Harness PC.

12. Junior drivers 6-10yrs **MUST** be accompanied in the cart by an experienced adult driver with a second pair of reins. Drivers 11-12yrs **MUST** be accompanied in the cart by an experienced adult. Drivers 13-15yrs must be accompanied by an experienced adult handler at all times.

13. At all NBS run events, children under 16yrs must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

### **FIRE REGULATIONS**

The use of primus or similar stoves or any heating or lighting appliances of a like nature or any naked light is strictly prohibited in or near any horse stall or pavilion. The alteration of or interference with any electrical wiring switch or plug is strictly forbidden.

### **ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY**

If cancellation of an event is required due to existing or predicted severe and dangerous conditions such as Code Red Fire Warnings/Floods or travel warnings/disease outbreaks, then the following policy will be adhered to: Cancellation will be decided from the 4-day weather forecast given on the Wednesday prior to the event.

Information regarding the status of the event will be available on the Society's website: [www.nbs.org.au](http://www.nbs.org.au) or from the relevant contact person.

1. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event, costs incurred by the Show Committee prior to the event will be paid and the remaining funds will be reimbursed to the exhibitor if the amount per exhibitor is \$10 or more.

2. If an event is postponed, entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement.

3. If an event has commenced there shall be no refunds.

### **RISK MANAGEMENT CONDITIONS**

- Riding of horses bareback is prohibited
- Riding of Rugged horses is prohibited
- Stallions must at all times be in the control of an adult 16yrs & over and must be bitted (except in show class where breed variations allow)
- Speed limits must be adhered to at all times
- Power leads must not cross roads or tracks
- Horses must not be kept in tape yards
