

RULES & REGULATIONS

- The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program and to reject any entry at its discretion, if the circumstances arise.
- All competitors ride at their own risk and no responsibility will be taken by the Organisers for any accident or injury to competitors, visitors or livestock.
- Approved ASA AS/NZS 3838, EN1384, ASTN F1163 must be worn whilst mounted and by juniors under 12yrs who are competing in led events and appropriate footwear must be worn.
- All exhibits must be registered with National Buckskin Society (Inc.) and exhibitors must be financial members
- Horses classified on the day are eligible to compete
- Show Hunter:
A Show Hunter should possess more substance than the modern ridden Show Horse but it must be emphasised they should be quality animals. A quality Show Hunter must create the impression that it is capable of hunting over a variety of terrain – this militates against weakness in conformation which would prevent this and he must do it comfortably and safely for his rider. The Show Hunter in competition is NOT required to jump.
The Show Hunter should have short, well-defined canons with sufficient forearm and second thigh. He must cover ground in all paces with a well balanced gallop, moving from the shoulder, and with the hind legs well under. A certain amount of knee action is permitted, while flat and stilled action is unacceptable.
Manners are extremely important and small misdemeanours, which may be overlooked in a Show Horse, should be penalised in the Show Hunter.
Saddlery should be clean, neat and well fitting, but may be more “workmanlike” than for a ridden show class.
The dress code for Show Hunter classes is generally far more conservative and understated than Show Horse classes.
Two very important factors about clothing which are sometimes overlooked, especially with children, are that everything should (a) fit the rider and (b) be comfortable to ride in.

Please Note: Where applicable, National Buckskin Society and EA rules and regulations apply.

ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

If cancellation of an event is required due to existing or predicted severe and dangerous conditions such as Code Red Fire Warnings/Floods or travel warnings/disease outbreaks, then the following policy will be adhered to:

Cancellation will be decided from the 4-day weather forecast given on the Wednesday prior to the event.

Information regarding the status of the event will be available on the Society's website: www.nbs.org.au or from the relevant contact person.

1. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event, costs incurred by the Show Committee prior to the event will be paid and the remaining funds will be reimbursed to the exhibitor if the amount per exhibitor is \$10 or more.

2. If an event is postponed, entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement.

3. If an event has commenced there shall be no refunds.
