

### **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- All exhibits must be registered with National Buckskin Society (Inc.) and exhibitors must be financial members
- Horses classified on the day are eligible to compete
- Exhibits may only compete in one Best Presented class for which they are eligible
- BROODMARE – Must be a minimum of 3 months in foal with positive test or with current year foal at foot.
- NOVICE – Is not to have won a first prize at a NBS A Class Show or a Royal / or Agricultural Show This applies to led, ridden and rider classes as appropriate.
- The National Buckskin Soc. (Inc) committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program.
- Section B & C Horses may only compete in classes where it stipulates the class is Open to Section B & C Horses.
- All competitors ride at their own risk and no responsibility will be taken by the Organisers for any accident or injury to competitors, visitors or livestock.
- Third generation buckskin exhibits must be a minimum of 3 generations NBS registered buckskins
- Horses competing in **Dual Registered Classes** **MUST** supply a photocopy of the relevant **Breed Registration and show proof of ownership**. Only **ONE** Dual Registered class is allowed per horse. Papers available on request.
- Entries in Pony Club & Adult Riding Club classes must be in full uniform and carry relevant papers
- Approved hard hats ASA AS/NZS 3838, EN1384, ASTN F1163 must be worn whilst mounted and by juniors under 12yrs who are competing in led events and appropriate footwear must be worn.
- Bred/Owned and Exhibited by 1 person – must be the person who bred the horse, owns the horse and is the person showing the horse in the ring. In the event of a family membership or stud membership only the nominee of the membership can show the horse in this class only. An exhibitor cannot enter in the Owner/Breeder class.
- Breeder/Owner class. This is open to a person who bred the horse and owns the horse (the handler of the horse can be anyone). An exhibitor cannot enter in both the Breeder/Owner class and the bred/Owned & Exhibited class
- Pleasure Horse/Pony must be ridden in a snaffle bit and bridle only
- Show Hunter:

A show Hunter should possess more substance than the modern ridden Show Horse but it must be emphasised they should be quality animals. A quality Show Hunter must create the impression that it is capable of hunting over a variety of terrain – and he must do it comfortably and safely for his rider. The Show Hunter in competition is NOT required to jump. Manners are extremely important and small misdemeanours, which may be overlooked in a Show Horse, should be penalised in the Show Hunter. Saddlery should be clean, neat and well fitting, but may be more “workmanlike” than for a ridden show class. The dress code for Show Hunter classes is generally far more conservative and understated than Show Horse classes. Two very important factors about clothing which are sometimes overlooked, especially with children, are that everything should (a) fit the rider and (b) be comfortable to ride in.

### **ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY**

If cancellation of an event is required due to existing or predicted severe and dangerous conditions such as Code Red Fire Warnings/Floods or travel warnings/disease outbreaks, then the following policy will be adhered to: Cancellation will be decided from the 4-day weather forecast given on the Wednesday prior to the event. Information regarding the status of the event will be available on the Society's website: [www.nbs.org.au](http://www.nbs.org.au) or from the relevant contact person. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event, costs incurred by the Show Committee prior to the event will be paid and the remaining funds will be reimbursed to the exhibitor if the amount per exhibitor is \$10 or more. If an event is postponed, entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement. If an event has commenced there shall be no refunds.
